CHANGING SMALL CHOICES – FUTURE IMPACT

Select one of the below scenarios to create two scenes exploring how small choices can have a huge impact.

The Act of Kindness:

Scenario: A student sees another classmate being bullied.

Choice A: The student steps in to help, leading to a new friendship and a safer, kinder environment.

Choice B: The student ignores the situation, which causes the bullying to continue and leaves both feeling isolated.

The Study or Play Decision:

Scenario: A student must decide whether to study for an upcoming test or spend the time playing video games.

Choice A: The student chooses to study, resulting in good grades and increased confidence.

Choice B: The student decides to play instead, leading to a poor test result and learning the value of preparation.

The Honesty Moment:

Scenario: A student accidentally breaks a classroom item and must decide whether to confess or hide the mistake.

Choice A: The student tells the truth, earning trust from the teacher and classmates and learning about responsibility.

Choice B: The student hides the mistake, which later results in more significant consequences when the truth is discovered.

Trying Something New:

Scenario: A student is offered a chance to join a new club or try a different sport but is nervous about failing.

Choice A: The student takes the risk, discovers a new talent, and builds lasting friendships.

Choice B: The student decides not to try, missing an opportunity to grow and connect with others.
